

Common Questions

Q. What is financial aid?

A. Financial aid is any kind of money that is either given or loaned to you for a period of time that can assist you in paying for school. In the 2015-2016 academic year, Ohio Christian University AGS students received over \$40 million dollars in financial aid assistance.

Q. How do I get financial aid?

A. You can receive most types of financial aid by filling out a FAFSA at www.fafsa.ed.gov and enter our school code: 003030.

Q. What is the FAFSA?

A. FAFSA stands for "Free Application for Federal Student Aid." Specifically, the FAFSA is a government document created by the U.S. Department of Education that assists the University in determining how much aid each student is eligible for.

Q. I do not think I will qualify for much, if any, financial aid. Do I still need to fill out the FAFSA?

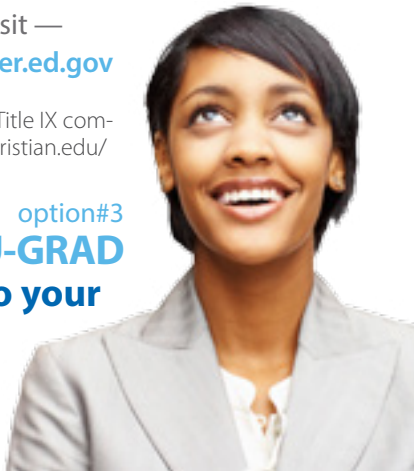

- ✓ Apply for admission to Ohio Christian University. Apply for admission online at www.ohiochristian.edu/apply and select the Adult and Graduate Studies link.
- ✓ Submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). You can complete the FAFSA at www.fafsa.ed.gov* OCU's school code is 003030.
- ✓ Submit additional admissions documents. High school diploma or GED, college transcripts, and reference forms, if applicable.
- ✓ Select a start date with your recruiter and fill out registration form.

Tuition & Fees

Students must pay first semester tuition at registration prior to the first class session, OR make arrangements for payment through school loans, grants, OCU online payment plan, or Employer Reimbursement/Tuition Deferment, if applicable.
